We are a rustic camp, run primarily by volunteers, so we ask you to make sure campers and leaders understand and follow the rules. This helps us ensure everyone's safety and keeps our rates low. Failure to comply with rules will result in being asked to leave without refund or not being allowed to return for future reservations. We do not want this to happen obviously, so please let us know if there is anything we can do to help better communicate the policies with campers.

Please have the main leader of the group read, sign and submit a copy of these rules prior to your stay.

_____ No loud noise, amplified music or outdoor activity after 10pm or before 8am.

_____ We share this property with several family homes. Please do not touch their belongings including playground equipment, bikes/scooters, strollers and gardens.

_____ Pick up your trash and empty trash cans as needed. We encourage groups to assign campers to do a 10 piece pick up game after lunch/dinner each day.

_____ Do not move bunk beds or furniture in the sleeping cabins. Items that have been moved will be considered lost and groups will be charged for them.

_____ No rough housing on furniture or MPR games (ping pong, pool table, Pop-A-Shot).

_____ When down by the basketball court, do not go past the two big trees and do not go into the Lagoon.

_____ Make sure the fire in the fire pit is completely out before leaving it for the night. An adult must be present by the fire pit whenever it is in use.

_____ No food or drinks in the MPR or any cabins. Food and drinks must be enjoyed outside, in the common area of the Lodge or in the Dining Hall.

_____ If anything breaks or gets damaged during your stay, please let the camp manager know immediately so we can clean up properly.

_____ Help us keep our rates affordable by being kind and gentle with our furniture, games and amenities. Groups will be financially responsible for broken or lost items.

I UNDERSTAND THAT I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR MAKING SURE CAMPERS RESPECT THE RULES. FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN BEING ASKED TO LEAVE OR NOT BEING ALLOWED TO BOOK WITH US AGAIN IN THE FUTURE. I UNDERSTAND THAT LOST, BROKEN OR DAMAGED ITEMS WILL BE REPLACED/REPAIRED USING THE DAMAGE DEPOSIT I PAY UPON ARRIVAL.
